Registration

Q: What is included in registration to the 2017 Native Broadcast Summit?

A: Broadcasters can expect access to trainings, training materials, panel discussions, and refreshments and meals.

Q: What is the cancellation policy for registration?

A: NPM asks that all cancellation or substitution requests be submitted in writing to Elyse Dempsey at edempsey@nativepublicmedia.org by April 3, 2017. Substitutions will be accepted for colleagues/associates from your organization.

Q: How do I change or update my information in my registration?

Lodging & Parking

Q: Are hotel accommodations included in the registration for the Summit?

A: Hotel reservations and accommodations are not included in registration for the Summit. Those in need of hotel accommodations may contact The Artesian Hotel. NPM has secured a hotel group rate of \$119 per night for King and Double Queen rooms. Q: What is the cancellation policy at The Artesian Hotel?

Meals

Q: What food service can I expect at the Summit?

A: The Summit will include PM refreshments on May 3rd; AM and PM refreshments, a catered lunch, and a catered dinner on May 4th; and AM refreshments and a catered lunch on May 5th. Breakfast will not be provided. However, The Artesian Hotel property is home to the Springs at the Artesian restaurant and the Bedré Café. Q: Can the Summit accommodate specific dietary requests?

A: Yes, to a degree. The catered refreshments and meal selections offered at the Summit will be comprised of various food items, served buffet-style. Dietary requests can be entered your registration in the comments field.

Travel & Transportation

Q: What is nearest airport to Sulphur, Oklahoma?

Q: Will there be airport shuttles?

A: Yes. Courtesy of the Chickasaw Nation, shuttles will only be provided on the following dates and times: May 3 at 2:30 p.m. and 5 p.m., May 5 at 3:30 p.m., and May 6 at a time to be determined. Because shuttles will only be available at these set times, NPM encourages you to plan your flight arrival and departure times accordingly.
